- Event winners must complete a W-9 and must show ID for payout
- ALL PAYOUTS WILL BE VOIDED AFTER 30 DAYS
- Final decisions will be based on MCTFR ground rules

**ENTRIES CLOSE: FEBRUARY 20, 2026 AT 5:00PM**


